Congratulations on being selected as a Camp Enterprise participant! Camp is scheduled for November 1-3, 2007, and will be held at Camp Courage near Annandale, Minnesota.

COMPLETION OF CONSENT FORMS

Please complete the enclosed **Camp Courage Consent and Release Form** (gold) and the **Outward Bound Agreement** (blue) and return them to our office immediately. You will not be able to participate without these completed forms. **FAX** both forms to us by Friday, October 26th, or you **must** bring them with you to the registration table at Camp Enterprise.

SCHOLARSHIPS

This year there will be several monetary scholarships awarded to students totaling approximately \$5,000. The scholarships will be based on camp participation in several categories including teamwork on a case study, attitude, and a brief essay. Winning students will be evaluated and selected by a team of Rotarians.

DEPARTURE AND PICK UP

Check-in time at the bus will be 9:30 AM. We will return to the same location on Saturday, November 3rd at about 4:00 PM. Driving to Camp is allowed under special circumstances only and is highly discouraged. Please contact Annie Kennedy, Program Administrator, for permission to drive. If approved, a member of the Edina Rotary Club will hold the keys to your vehicle for the duration of the Camp.

We are looking forward to meeting your son or daughter at the Camp Enterprise weekend on November 1-3, 2007. The event will be held at Camp Courage near Annandale, Minnesota.

Charter bus transportation is provided and will depart on Thursday, November 1st at 10:00 AM from the Edina Water Tower located at the southwest corner of the Southdale Shopping Center (France Avenue and 69th Street), Edina MN. **Check-in time at the bus is 9:30 AM.** We will drop the students off at the same location on Saturday, November 3rd at approximately 4:00 PM. Driving to Camp is allowed under special circumstances only. Please contact Annie Kennedy, Program Administrator, at 952-946-8708 to discuss driving issues. We highly discourage students from driving themselves to the camp. If they do drive, we will keep their keys for the duration of the Camp. For students going directly to the Camp on Thursday morning, check-in time is 11:00 AM.

Please assist us by returning the **Consent and Release Form** (gold) and the **Outward Bound Agreement** (blue). Please note that **your signature is required** on these forms. Students will not be able to attend Camp if we have not received your consent in writing. If you cannot mail or fax both forms to us by Friday, October 26th, your student **must bring them to the Camp registration table.**

Students are closely monitored during the weekend with a minimum of 20 Rotarian men and women supervising the students. We also hire a group of college and post-college young people as counselors to supervise and facilitate. Some of the counselors participated in Camp Enterprise when they were high school students. **In case of emergency, the Camp Courage phone number is (320) 963-3121.**
