



TECHNOLOGY USAGE GUIDELINES

While at Camp Enterprise, use of cell phones, smart phones, computers, tablets and other electronic devices is subject to the following guidelines:

- Students must exercise good judgment and show respect for fellow students, volunteers, and speaker at all times.
- Cell phones, smart phones, computers, tablets and other electronic devices may not be used during speakers or presentations. Ring tones should be silenced at all times.
- Wireless internet is available at Camp Enterprise. Use of Wi-Fi is limited to camp purposes only. Due to limited bandwidth, no personal use of Wi-Fi is allowed. Uploading or downloading files and streaming audio or video is prohibited.
- Accessing, downloading, creating, sending or displaying harmful or offensive content is prohibited.
- Use of technology for any illegal activity or purpose is prohibited.
- Files and electronic communications are not private. Phones and computers are subject to search at any time.
- If a counselor, mentor or other volunteer instructs you to turn off your device for any reason, you must do so immediately.

With respect to case study presentations, the following additional guidelines apply:

- Presentations may consist of no more than 24 slides and must feature all team members.
- Each student must participate in the development of the presentation and will have ultimate responsibility for the content of their slides.
- Slides are intended to serve as a guide and supplement to the presentation. Students are required to make their presentations “live and in person.”
- Presentations may feature one pre-recorded “commercial” up to 60 seconds in length but may not incorporate any other audio or video elements.

Failure to follow these guidelines may result in loss of the privilege to use technology and the internet and/or confiscation of your device. In extreme cases, failure to follow these guidelines may result in your disqualification or removal from camp.
